

The Midlands youth swimming championships saw five Harborough based swimmers competing at the Corby International pool over the bank holiday weekend.

Candice Hall dominated proceedings in the ladies 15/16 age group winning three individual gold, two silver and two bronze medals. Hall also competed as part of a very successful City of Leicester team taking silver in the freestyle relays and going one better to be crowned midlands champions in the medley relay. Hall's achievements also included new lifetime bests and club records for the 200m breast, fly and individual medley. Olivia Weller qualified to swim in four events with her most successful a tenth place finish in the 200m breast stroke with a new personal best time. Kirsty Haynes made a very welcome return to the championships competing in the 50m fly.

Ewan Ronald swam in six events reaching the final of the Men's 15/16 age group 200m fly where he finished a very credible fifth place. Ronald had a particular strong weekend at the fly events breaking the Harborough Swimming club records over 50m, 100m and 200m.

Harry Waddington set an electric pace in the men's open 50m freestyle setting a new life time best and club record, which saw him finish twelfth overall.
